Due to COVID19 restrictions we are conducting the sale following guidelines to keep our bidders and sale staff safe. The sale will take place inside the Agricultural Building with spaced seating. Masks and social distancing expected.

- The animals and exhibitors will be shown on large screens in the order they are to be sold.
- There will be a sale catalog to provide you with the information you need to select an animal that will suit your needs.
- Templeton Auctioneers will conduct the auction, and the CCYL committee will handle all the transactions.
- Buyers are expected to be prepared with cash or check the day of the sale.
- If you are planning to buy for your own use, we encourage you to contact one of the processors we have arranged, or, make arrangements with a processor of your choice – including hauling.
- All animals will be hauled out on sale day. Once an animal is sold, it is the property of the buyer. If you need the youth to care for the animal for a few days until your processing spot opens, please make arrangements with the exhibitor's family.
- **SWINE** – Because we are housing (co-mingling) the hogs for less than 72 hours, we are able to allow our buyers the option of taking the swine home or to a local butcher that you have made arrangements with. They will not be required to go to a USDA inspected location. If this is the best option for you – please make hauling arrangements. We need to move all pigs out on the 7th.
- **All animals must be picked up by 5:00 pm. Exhibitors and event volunteers will provide assistance.**
